What is a Prayer/Action Chapter?

The nondenominational Prayer/Action Chapter meetings serve as an arm of the church to encourage informed prayer and action for our nation and its leaders. CWA does this by educating Christians on issues that affect our Biblically based standards. We want to empower you as either a leader or Chapter member to deal with the issues of education, abortion, pornography, religious freedom, homosexuality, redefinition of the family and national sovereignty.

How does a Prayer/Action Chapter work?

The Prayer/Action Chapter has a three-fold purpose, providing an opportunity for members to do the following:

- 1.) Be alert and INFORMED on the issues. (Ephesians 6:18b)
- 2.) PRAY about the issues. (Ephesians 6:18a)
- 3.) ACT on those issues. (Ephesians 6:20)

Meetings can be held in homes, churches or community centers. A Chapter can start with as few as three and grow to an unlimited number. Meeting regularly, preferably monthly, is most effective.
